The majority of the population is deprived of basic health measures. This situation began to change in 1990 in the District of Sirohi (where Mt. Abu is situated) with the establishment of the J. Watumull Memorial Global Hospital and Research Centre initiated by the Brahma Kumaris. Designed to provide high quality, modern, holistic healthcare services in a tranquil, rural environment, the hospital is managed and run by a charitable trust established and supported by members of the Brahma Kumaris. It offers free or subsidised treatment and medicine to 100,000 people, of whom 54,000 are tribal, living in the district's 855 villages.

It was in 1936 when a famous diamond merchant, Dada Lekhraj, in the late fifties of his life had a number of divine visions in a very short period. He had a vision of the Incorporeal God Father Shiva, the Being of Light. He saw a value-based society which will become an emerging reality in a few decades. He also saw great catastrophic end of the present order because of utter moral degradation of mankind. He then had a divine call to rise and be a human medium so that the Divine may speak and manifest through him. It was in response to this call that the **PRAJAPITA BRAHMAKUMARIS ISHWARIYA VISHWA VIDYALAYA** was formally founded in the year 1937. It started as a family gathering and now has become a gigantic tree with about 6000 branches spread over 72 countries.

To accomplish its aim of re-establishing moral and spiritual values in the society, the institution undertook various service projects from time to time. With a vision of a better world order, the different segments of the society were inspired for their united co-operation. This basic idea gave rise to a new sister organisation-"Rajyoga Education and Research Foundation". It is a registered institution under the Societies Registration Act of 1860.

The main objective of the Foundation is to raise the moral standard of the society, to eradicate ignorance, superstitions and social evils as well as to impart spiritual

education and Rajyoga in order to build a new society based on divine virtues and full of happiness and peace. The foundation has many wings for the service of various segments of the society such as Educationists, Jurists, Doctors, Women, Scientists and Engineers etc. **It has also a very active and widespread Medical Wing.**

With the Joint efforts of both the institutions, Brahmakumaris was awarded a Peace Medal as well as one International and five national Peace Messenger Awards by United Nations. It is affiliated to Dept. of Public Information of UN as NGO and holds a consultative status on the Economic and Social Council of the UN. It is also affiliated to UNICEF.
